

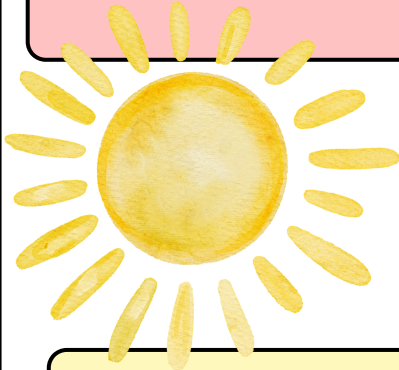

UTILITY DISCONNECT FOR NON-PAYMENT

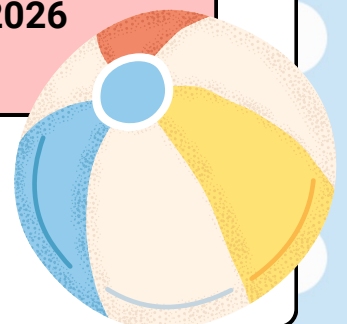
